Regional Spatial Strategy to 2026

The East Midlands Regional Plan (Regional Spatial Strategy) (RSS) was published on 12 March 2009. This is a revision of the Regional Spatial Strategy for the East Midlands (RSS8, March 2005), and replaces it as the RSS for the region.

The Regional Plan provides a framework for development and investment up to 2026 and is part of the statutory development plan for the East Midlands region.

Any person aggrieved by the revision to the regional spatial strategy for the East Midlands may make an application to the High Court under section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the RSS is not within the powers conferred by Part 1 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.

Such an application must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks starting on 12 March 2008.
