

Upper Lee Valley Area Partnership

The Upper Lee Valley Area Partnership covers the parts of the London Boroughs of Haringey and Enfield. At ward level the following areas are covered:

(Please note these are the 2001 electoral wards identified in the Single Programme Document.)

In the first half of the Objective 2 Programme (2000-2003) the Upper Lee Valley has secured £12,709,626 of Objective 2 funding to support local communities (£1,919,102); businesses (£5,334,770) and strategic sites (£5,455,754) in Haringey and Enfield.

- 39 projects were granted funding in the first round (2001) and have been operating successfully in the area since April 2001
- 12 projects will begin from January 2003 that were granted funding under the second bidding round. In addition there are 4 projects impacting on a wider London Objective 2 area that will benefit the ULV.

ULV Objective 2 Programme Vision

The vision for the Objective 2 programme in the Upper Lee Valley is:

To close the gap between the Upper Lee and the rest of London by tackling barriers to economic opportunity in those parts of the area suffering industrial decline, urban deprivation, low economic activity and social exclusion so that new sustainable opportunities are open to all people living and working in the Upper Lee.

ULV Area Partnership

The ULV Area Partnership plays a role in co-ordinating the delivery of Objective 2 in the area. The Partnership is comprised of representatives from a wide variety of organisations including those from the voluntary, public and private sector. The Area Partnership delegated authority for local delivery of the Objective 2 programme to the ULV Executive Group.

The Executive Group is responsible for managing the delivery of the Objective 2 programme in the area. The Group is comprised of the following organisations:

It is the responsibility of the group to:

- interpret information on the Objective 2 programme and the process provided by GoL, Brussels, or cross partnership bodies;
- be aware of other European and local regeneration programmes that complement Objective 2 and impact / can affect the Upper Lee area
- implement the Objective 2 area strategy through the development of the programme;
- ensure sub groups are linked and have access to / are able to contribute to debates on a variety of issues relevant to Objective 2 and other regeneration programmes.
- direct the area partnerships perspective to regional initiatives and cross Partnership Forums (such as LEPC for Objectives 2 and 3);
- oversee the project development and assessment process, so that the programme is accessible to a wide range of potential bidders and that the processes used in the area for support are appropriately and consistently implemented across each of the sub groups;
- recommend strategic package of projects to Urban Futures Board
- discuss and resolve procedural issues as they arise
- advise the Objective 2 Staff Team on the development and delivery of the Upper Lee Valley Objective 2 programme

Bidding Rounds

There are no bidding rounds currently happening for Objective 2 Funding. The Local Economic Partnership (LEP) is currently being developed in the Upper Lee. This group is building on the local neighbourhood structure underdevelopment in each of the identified neighbourhoods: Seven Sisters NDC area; Noel Park; Northumberland Park; Broadwater Farm (all in Haringey) and Edmonton (in Enfield). ULV has a notional allocation of European Funds (ESF and ERDF) for Priority 1 activity as follows:
