Statement of Publication of the Regional Spatial Strategy for South East England – the South East Plan

The Regional Spatial Strategy (RSS) for South East England was published on 6 May 2009. This replaces Regional Planning Guidance for the South East (RPG9, 2001) as the RSS for the region.

Copies of the RSS and accompanying documents (including a schedule listing the final changes to the RSS and the reasons for them, and a consolidated sustainability appraisal report and Habitats Regulations Assessment) are available for inspection during normal working hours at:

- the Government Office for the South East, Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, Surrey GU1 4GA;
- the principal offices of local planning authorities throughout the region;
- main county libraries.

The documents are also available to view or download from the website of the Government Office for the South East (www.gos.gov.uk/gose).

Any person who is aggrieved by the RSS may make an application to the High Court under section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 no later than the end of a period of six weeks starting on 6 May 2009 on the grounds that:

1. the RSS is not within the powers conferred by Part 1 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or
2. a procedural requirement has not been complied with.
