

# London and South East of England Industrial Development Board -Vacancy for Board Members

## ***Make a difference to your region***

Government grants, called Selective Finance for Investment in England (SFIE), are available to support certain capital investment in parts of London and the South East of England to promote economic development. The London and the South East England Industrial Development Board (LSEIDB) makes recommendations on SFIE applications from £250,000 to £2 million, on the basis of papers presented by the appraisal team at the London Development Agency (LDA) and the South East England Development Agency (SEEDA).

We are looking for a number of candidates with a successful business record to become Board members and give informed collective advice on applications for a wide variety of financial and commercial projects.

Board members would be expected to have a wide experience and proven ability at a senior level in industry, banking, accounting, finance and current or recent personal involvement in a decision-taking role in the planning, financing and/or management of investment projects in the private sector. We would be particularly interested in applicants with a background in industry or property.

Appointments are usually made for an initial period of three years. Members may be re-appointed for subsequent terms, up to a maximum of ten years.

Board members are appointed under guidelines drawn up by the Office of the Commissioner of Public Appointments and as such are in accordance with equal opportunities policy. We welcome applications from women and from disabled and ethnic minority persons. Appointments will be made on merit.

## ***Remuneration***

LSEIDB Members are not paid but are reimbursed for travel and expenses. Meetings are held monthly, as necessary, in the morning at a venue in London.

The closing date for applications is **5<sup>th</sup> October 2007**. It is anticipated that interviews will take place week commencing 5<sup>th</sup> November with successful Board members taking up their posts on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2008.
