**In accordance with section 113(3) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, any person aggrieved by the relevant document may make an application to the High Court no later than the end of a period of six weeks starting on 15<sup>th</sup> July 2008 on the grounds that:**

**a) the document is not within the relevant power granted by Part 1 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004; or**

**b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.**
